<b>T-shirt</b>	tishirt	A lightweight shirt with short sleeves.	Camiseta	She wore a black <b>t-shirt</b> to the gym.
<b>Jeans</b>	jins	Casual trousers typically made of denim.	Vaqueros	He loves wearing <b>jeans</b> and a t-shirt.
<b>Dress</b>	dres	A one-piece garment for women or girls.	Vestido	She bought a red <b>dress</b> for the party.
<b>Sweater</b>	sweater/ suerer	A knitted garment worn on the upper body.	Suéter	He put on a cozy <b>sweater</b> in winter.
<b>Skirt</b>	ssquert	Garment worn by women that hangs from the waist.	Falda	She wore a long floral <b>skirt</b> to work.
<b>Shorts</b>	shorts	Garment shorter than trousers.	Pantalones cortos	He wore <b>shorts</b> at the beach.
<b>Jacket</b>	yaquet	A short coat worn over other clothes.	Chaqueta	She wore a stylish leather <b>jacket</b> .

<b>Shoes</b>	shus	Footwear covering the feet.	Zapatos	She bought new running <b>shoes</b> .
<b>Socks</b>	socs	Garment worn on the feet.	Calcetines	He put on warm wool <b>socks</b> in winter.
<b>Coat</b>	cout	A long outer garment worn in cold weather.	Abrigo	She wore a wool <b>coat</b> in the snow.
<b>Blouse</b>	blaus	A woman's upper garment resembling a shirt.	Blusa	She wore a silk <b>blouse</b> to the party.
<b>Suit</b>	sut	A set of garments consisting of a jacket and trousers or a jacket and skirt.	Traje	He wore a tailored <b>suit</b> to the meeting.
<b>Tie</b>	tai	A long piece of cloth worn around the neck.	Corbata	He wore a colorful <b>tie</b> with his suit.
<b>Leggings</b>	leguins	Tight-fitting stretch pants worn by women.	Leggins	She wore black <b>leggings</b> to the gym.
<b>Hoodie</b>	judi	A sweatshirt with a hood.	Sudadera con capucha	He loves his favorite <b>hoodie</b> .
<b>Pajamas</b>	piyamas	Clothing for sleeping, often consisting of a top and pants.	Pijama	She wore comfortable <b>pajamas</b> to bed.
<b>Belt</b>	belt	A strip of leather or other material worn around the waist.	Cinturón	He wore a brown leather <b>belt</b> with his jeans.
<b>Gloves</b>	glovs	Covering for the hand, often with separate sections for the fingers.	Guantes	She wore wool <b>gloves</b> in the cold.
<b>Underwear</b>	ander uer	Clothing worn beneath outer clothes, usually next to the skin.	Ropa interior	He bought new <b>underwear</b> at the store
<b>Hat</b>	jat	Head covering with a brim or crown.	Sombrero	He wore a straw <b>hat</b> on the beach.
